Moses Sends the Spies

Exodus 3:8, 23:20-23;

Numbers 13:23, 13:27-28, 13:32-33

Moses sent twelve men to spy out the Promised Land.

Students will be able to describe God's promise of a land for the Israelites and they will be able to compare the faith of Joshua and Caleb with the faith of other spies.

God Judges Rebellion

Numbers 16:1-3, 16:12-14, 21:5-9;

John 3:14-15

God punished the people for rebelling and complaining.

The students will be able to explain God's judgment on Korah for his rebellion against Moses and explain God's mercy to the Israelites through the bronze serpent.

God Prepares the Way

Deuteronomy 3:1-5; Numbers 22:26-

35, 23:8-12

God helped the Israelites defeat the Amorite kings and receive blessings from Balaam.

Students will be able to describe the battles won over the Amorites and how God protected the Israelites from Balaam's curse.

Lesson 64

Rahab Helps the Spies

Joshua 1:5-6, 2:1, 2:11, 6:25;

Hebrews 11:31

Rahab believed in God and helped the Israelite spies in Jericho.

Students will be able to identify how Joshua became the leader of the Israelites and describe how God used Rahab to accomplish his plan for his people.

Memory Verse K-2nd Grade: Joshua 1:9, "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

Memory Verse (L61-65) 3rd-5th Grade: Deuteronomy 7:9, "Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations."
